Beth Brown – Managing Director, Nightwood Theatre
Term: Entering 1st year of 3 year term

Bio: Beth Brown was appointed as Managing Director of Nightwood Theatre in July 2014. Prior to this, Beth was General Manager of Theatre Direct, where she oversaw the creation of a fully equipped theatre and education space in the Artscape Wychwood Barns. She has worked in theatre as a Stage Manager, Technical Director, Production Manager and General Manager for various theatre companies, overseeing a multitude of productions, including national and international tours. As Managing Director of Nightwood, she has had the opportunity to work with various professional consultants to strengthen the procedures related to Board

Governance, and Fundraising and Development, and ensure a strong strategic plan is in place to take Nightwood Theatre into the future. Beth sits on various committees for the Professional Association of Canadian Theatres (PACT), including the Finance, Diversity and Labour Relations Committee, and is a Board Member for Eldritch Theatre Company. She received her Bachelor of Music degree at Queen's University and is a graduate of The National Theatre School of Canada.
