

Type of Test We Offer

RT-PCR: Reverse transcription polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) is a laboratory technique combining reverse transcription of RNA into DNA, it is often considered the gold standard of testing in Canada for identifying COVID-19.

ANTIGEN: Antigen testing detects the presence of viral proteins in a biological sample returning results in 15-20 minutes. This method of testing is for screening purposes and must be followed up with a PCR to confirm the pres- ence of COVID-19

All testing materials used by Switch Health are Health Canada approved.

Swabbing Techniques

- ✓ Bilateral Anterior Swab is less invasive and results in less patient discomfort. A swab is inserted into both nostrils about 1cm for 15 seconds each side.
- ✓ Nasopharyngeal Swab is a method for collecting a clinical test sample of nasal secretions from the back of the nose and throat. A swab is inserted into the back of the nasal cavity to the nasopharynx and swabbed for 8 to 10 seconds
- ✓ Saliva Collection is a collection method used for rapid testing which can detect the presence of COVID-19 using saliva obtained from a patients mouth.
